Chapter 2 Major Findings

2.1 Number of establishments

Considering some basic information establishments located in municipal areas and non-municipal areas in Northeastern region, it was found that there were in total 650,319 establishments. About 35.2 percent of the establishments were engaged in retail trade. This was followed by those engaged in manufacturing (about 27.7 percent). The establishments engaged in *accommodation*, food and beverage service activities, other service activities and wholesale and retail trade; repair of motor vehicles and motorcycles had a proportion of about 9.4 percent, 7.5 percent and 6.8 percent respectively. The other economic activities not mentioned above, each had less than 4.0 percent of the total

Considering the distribution of establishments by area, (Table A) it was found that, there were in total 271,263 establishments in municipal areas, of which the pattern of economic activities was similar as mentioned above. That is, most of establishments engaged in *retail trade*. This was followed by those engaged in *manufacturing* and accommodation, food and beverage service activities respectively. For the 379,056 establishments which were in non-municipal areas, most of them engaged in manufacturing. This was followed by those engaged in *retail* trade and accommodation, food and beverage service activities respectively.

2.2 Size of establishment

The size of establishment was specified by number of persons engaged in the establishment. It was found that most of them (about 642,228 establishments or 98.8 percent) engaged in establishments with 1-15 persons. Those engaged in establishments with 16 persons or more were about 1.2 percent. Of this number, establishments with 16-25 persons was about 0.6 percent, establishments with 31-50 persons and 51-200 persons were about 0.2 percent. For the establishments with 26-30 and more than 200 persons were about 0.1 percent.

Considering by economic activity, more than 86.0 percents in all kind of economic activities engaged in establishments with 1-15 persons. This was except for those engaged in *private hospital activities* with more than 50 persons, which was of about 77.5 percents (Table B).

2.3 Form of legal organization

For the form of legal organization of establishment in Northeastern region, most of establishments (about 95.9 percent) were in the form of individual proprietor. This was followed by those in the form of government, state-enterprise cooperative and others were about 2.2 percent. The rest of about 1.0 and 0.9 percent were in the form of company limited or public company limited and juristic partnership, respectively. Considering the economic activity, the result showed that most of establishments in all kind of economic activities were individual proprietor. This was followed by those, which were company limited, public company limited and those of juristic partnership, government, state-enterprise, cooperative and others respectively.

2.4 Form of economic organization

For the form of economic organization, Table D shows that most of establishments were in the form of single unit, which had the highest proportion of about 99.0 percent. About 0.9 percent were branch offices, while establishments in head office and others had the proportion, of about 0.1 percent. Considering the economic activity, it was found that more than 80.0 percent of establishments in all kind of economic activities were in the form of single unit.

2.5 Foreign investment or share holding

On the aspect of having foreign investment or share holding. Table E shows that, about 6,561 establishments were in the form of *company limited or public company limited*, whereas most of them had no foreign investment or share holding. For the establishments with foreign investment (1.6 percent), about 52.9 percent was of establishments with the foreign share holding around 10-50 percent, followed by 28.8 percent for establishments with foreign share less than ten percent. The rest of about 18.3 percent had foreign investment with a share holding over fifty percent.

Considering the economic activity, it was found that most establishments in all type of economic activities had the same structure as mentioned above. It was particularly for the establishments engaged in *art, entertainment and recreation* and *manufacturing* which had higher proportions of establishments with foreign investment than those of other economic activities, of about 5.0 percent. The following were *information and communication* about 3.2 percents.

2.6 Persons engaged and employees 2.6.1 Number of persons engaged

Focusing on the number of persons engaged, Table F shows that there were in total 1.7 million persons worked in establishments in Northeastern region. Most of them (about 1,199,042 persons or 71.7 percents) worked in the establishments with 1-15 persons. This was followed by establishments with more than 200 persons, of about 11.1 percents. For the establishments with 51-200 persons, 16-25 persons and 31-50 persons, there were about 7.2 percent, 4.9 percent and 3.5 percent respectively. Establishments with 26-30 persons had the lowest proportion of about 1.6 percent.

Considering by economic activity, it appeared that workers in *manufacturing* were about 576,255 persons or 34.5 percent. This was followed by those engaged in *retail trade* of about 29.6 percent. The other economic activities not mentioned above had rather low proportions of number of persons engaged, of which each economic activity had less than 10.0 percent.

2.6.2 Number of employees

In terms of number of employees, the total employees amounted to 622,712 persons. The employees engaged in establishments, with 1-15 persons were about 42.6 percent. This was followed by those engaged in establishments with more than 200 persons and 51-200 persons, of about 26.2 and 13.0 percent respectively. For the other sizes not mention above that rater low proportions of number of employees, of which each size had less than 9.0 percent.

For number of employees in each economic activity, it was found that employees engaged in *manufacturing* had the highest proportions of about 41.9 percent. This was followed by those engaged in *retail trade* of about 16.9 percent. While the other economic activities had the low proportions of number of employees, of which each economic activity had less than 9.0 percent, especially those engaged in *sewerage, waste management and remediation activities* had the lowest proportion of about 0.3 percent.

2.7 Sale of goods/services via internet

Table G shows that few of establishments in Northeastern region operated sale of goods/services via internet, of which it was found 1,437 establishments or about 0.2 percent. Establishments engaged in *Information and communication* were found the highest proportion, of about 1.6 percent. For other the economic activities, it was found a low proportion of performing of sale of goods via internet, of which each economic activity had less than 1.0 percent.
